

Dear Y6 Parents/Carers,

Next week is SATs week for all Y6 pupils across the country. We have been working hard to prepare them for these tests, whilst trying to keep the stress as low as we can. We do recognise that formal testing – as we are legally required to do – can be stressful for our pupils but we try to keep it in perspective! However, we all want our Y6s to do their very best and to show what they are capable of.

The tests will take place with at least two members of staff supervising and strict exam conditions will be observed e.g. no talking, displays will be covered etc. Some of our pupils receive 25% extra time to complete the test. This is applied for on the basis of any additional educational need that has been identified.

What we would like from you as parents/carers:

- please make sure your child is in school promptly for all of SATs week.

- in the event of serious illness, please contact the school swiftly so that we can make the necessary
arrangements. Missing a day has quite serious implications (we have to keep your child separate from the rest
of Y6 on their return and they are unable to use school transport) until the SATs tests have been completed.
 - give your child a good breakfast and help them get a good night's sleep before hand! Coming to school wellfed and well-rested is a really positive way into each day.

- reinforce the message that it is important to try your best and give them bucket loads of encouragement!
