Payment and Prices

Our pre-school hourly rates have now increased to £6 per hour. This is a 50p increase per hour (non-funded hours) and is necessary to cover our increased running costs.

Our school meal cost has risen to £2.40/meal (for those in KS2 and pre-school). Once again, this cost increase reflects the increased costs of energy and ingredients.

We would really appreciate payment for dinners to be made in advance at the beginning of the week, where possible. We do understand that occasionally plans will change and this may not always be possible. You may wish to consider paying a lump sum at the beginning of a week, month or half term—to do this, change the amount on Eduspot and add the item to your basket. Please book in advance for breakfast and after school club. Payment should be made at the point of booking. We will not necessarily have staff available unless pre-bookings are made.

Ready Respectful Safe

We have three school rules:

- Ready
- Respectful
- Safe

We are using these rules to understand how to behave appropriately and get the most out of life in school.

Ready

- PE kit in school
- Correct uniform
- Right equipment at the right time
- Listen to instructions.
- Be mentally ready to learn and talk to someone if your head is not in the right place.

Respectful

- Listen to each other (adults and children alike)
- Speak politely and respectfully (no swearing)
- Be respectful of everyone's right to learn in a calm, safe environment
- Respect yourself—eat, sleep, exercise and drink plenty of water

Safe

- Use equipment appropriately (e.g. in PE)
- Follow instructions
- Be where you should be!
- Stay safe online
- Consider other people's safety too
