Car Seats: The Law

We have had reports that some children are not being safely strapped into appropriate car seats. This is extremely concerning as the risk of not obeying the law is that a child could be seriously injured, or even fatally injured, in the event of a collision. Sadly, too many families locally have lost loved ones as a result of road traffic accidents. Please, please ensure your child is safely strapped in on **all** journeys.
