#### Promoting Positive Behaviour



At Long Mountain, we continue to set high expectations, standards and aspirations for children to thrive in a positive and nurturing environment.

Last year we updated our behaviour policy to reflect the latest and most up-to-date training, research, guidance and currant practice to maintain our high expectations and standards of behaviour.

To support the pupils in promoting positive behaviour this year we will be developing three key areas:

**Firstly,** we are continuing our 3 'over-arching' rules that run across all contexts of the school which children should understand and adhere to at all times.:

#### Ready, Respectful, Safe

**Secondly**, we will be introducing **Positive Notes** which is a reward system for staff and visitors to recognise pupils going over and above with behaviour or in recognition of displaying school values. This system allows pupils to take these home and show parents. Each will be accompanied by a Class Dojo Point.

**Thirdly,** staff shall use Class Dojo to reward positive behaviour. Pupils who receive the highest number of points each week will be presented with a Dojo Certificate during our Friday 'Celebration Worship'.
